With Valentine's Day right in the middle of the month, February often becomes an entire month about love. So often it's a month where romance is in the air and we see cards with words like "you have my whole heart my whole life." Inspired by love, this month we're going to be focusing not on romantic love, but instead on loving God. Our focus for this month will be loving the Lord with our whole heart.

Specifically, we will be doing a sermon series on the book of Malachi. The book of Malachi is only 4 chapters long. It's a minor prophet and the last book of the Old Testament. As we read the book of Malachi, we will see that the people are struggling to follow the Lord with their whole heart. In good news, they haven't completely turned their back on the Lord. They aren't worshipping idols like their ancestors before them. In bad news, their worship is not up to the Lord's standards. They don't love the lord with their whole heart either. Their love for the Lord is only halfhearted.

We too struggle with loving the Lord with our whole heart as well. We go to church on Sundays, we maybe even participate in a weekly Bible Study, or pray over our meals, but it's done half-heartedly. In the gospels, Jesus tells us the greatest commandment is "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind." (Matthew 22:36)

I know we have many people in our congregation who love the Lord. However, many of us struggle to love him with all of our heart, all our soul, and with all our mind. We love him halfheartedly. Things get in the way of our love for the Lord. Life circumstances get in the way. We can even turn good gifts from God into idols.

This month, as we read through the book of Malachi and see the halfhearted love the Israelites were struggling with, I hope we recognize this struggle in ourselves. But I hope we don't stop with simply recognizing how we have this struggle. I hope that we ask the Holy Spirit to reveal to us the places in our lives where we don't fully love the Lord. When the Holy Spirit reveals those places in our heart to us, I hope we pray to the Lord to transform us into people with hearts on fire for the Lord. I hope we become people who whole heartedly love the Lord with all of our heart, all of our soul, and all of our mind. Let's journey together this month as we read God's word to become people who are whole heartedly in love with our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.
