
Pastor Katie's Message

For anyone who writes a prisoner in the Florida system, there is a big change. All prisoners mail must be mailed to the new center where it is scanned and put in their e-mail system:

> Inmate's last name, first name, DC# PO BOX 23608 Tampa, FL 33623

Unfortunately, this means that we can no longer send them cards to mail to others, postage stamps, or items such as a bookmarks, which we have sent in the past.
