**Greetings Highlands Family!** 

I am grateful and blessed to be serving as your pastor during this next season of Highlands UMC. The joy each of you have brought over these past five weeks has been an out pouring of God's love. I am looking forward to meeting and getting to know each of you more as we move forward in the next steps God has planned for us. If I have not had a chance to sit and talk with you, I would love to hear from you. Each of your voices matter as we journey together to complete God's work. I plan to have a presence at the church office on a regular basis that I am trying to work out. So hopefully this month of August, I will begin to feel more settled into my wonderful new home — our church campus and at the parsonage.

Typically, I would not be sharing about myself personally in our monthly newsletter, but I sense you may want to know a little more about your new pastor other than she likes Greek food and sunflowers! First of all I see my appointment here at HUMC as God's calling. God's pastoral calling is my second vocation. Before God calling me into pastoral ministry, God called me back to Him later in my adult life. My first call is to God and second call is as your pastor. This quote from John Cassin explains my faith, "To cling always to God and to the things of God—this must be our major effort, this must be the road that the heart follows unswervingly" (Farina, John Cassian Conferences, p. 42). In the morning, we would put on our hard hats and go to work, expecting each person to return safely home to their families. Through my career, I see how God has prepared me to oversee and love His church as a faithful shepherd of His flock. I was blessed through my career and now see the hand of God through it as God guided me even



when I did not realize and know about God's grace.

The last five years I have served God through mostly studying, so He could continue to prepare me for where He was leading – HUMC! I completed my BA in Christian Ministry at Trinity International University in South Florida. Thereafter, God called me to study on the Asbury Theological Seminary main campus in Wilmore, KY. At ATS I received a Master of Divinity with a concentration in Spiritual Formation. During my time at seminary it was a blessing to serve as a teacher's assistant under the Professor of Spiritual Formation, the D.N.A. Coach under the VP of Formation for the 800 + on-line students, and as a Garden Assistant at the ATS Garden of the Nations. My time in Wilmore was fruitful and a great blessing during this season of my life. Such a very special and holy place.

For such a time as this, God has called me to pastor His church – Highlands United Methodist Church in JAX, FL! We are partners together to complete the work God has called us to in our community and the world around us. Let's make disciples through the transforming love of Jesus Christ! You are a blessing.


